Incentive Points Breakdown

The Achievement Program is set up to encourage Youth to Promote Beef in numerous ways and be involved in their Association. Through yearly activities including social events, educational events, community events, Beef Shows and Leadership roles to list a few.

- * The breakdown of points, are from yearly events that any NYJBPA member should participate in. Every time you participate in an event, **you must record your points**. Record keeping is very important!
- * Other events, Beef related, that you attend can be added if approved by the Junior Director/NYBPA Secretary. A brief explanation needs to be submitted to Junior Director/NYBPA Secretary within 1 week of the event.
- * Any event marked with an asterisk * next to it is an event that requires a brief description of what was learned when attending the event and an agenda or schedule of events from the event needs to be submitted with point totals.

All Juniors participating in the Achievement Program will receive:

- *A FREE Banquet Dinner at the Annual Awards Banquet in January at the NYBPA Annual Winter Conferences.
- *A Certificate Award for the category level.
- *A Monetary Award for the category level set by the NYJBPA at their Annual Meeting.
- *A Monetary Award for an Educational Trip set by the NYJBPA at their Annual Meeting, see pg. 2.

Categories are:

Honorable Mention- 100-200 points earned.

Bronze- up to 201 - 400 points earned.

Silver- up to 401 - 800 points earned.

Gold- over 801 points earned.

Incentive Points Breakdown

In past years the qualifying Juniors have had a chance to submit a formal request for Money towards a trip to a National show. We will again be honoring that program but before we can proceed the Juniors must set the dollar amount to be given based on level of participation in the program. For example:

Gold - \$250
Silver - \$150
Bronze - \$100

This is just a guideline but the amount must be set and voted for at the January meeting. I think the following should also be considered along with the trip to a National Show:

- Trip to a National Convention (ex: FFA, NCBA, Etc.)
- Trip to Participate in Livestock Judging at a National Level
- Educational Trip (ex: Pride (Hereford Assoc.), LEAD (Angus Assoc.))

Formal requests for these trips will need to be submitted by 4/1 and following the trip the member must provide a short report and something from the trip (show program, itinerary, etc.). We would need the items listed from your attendance, submitted to Directors within 7 days after the end of the event, then payment would be reimbursed.

**This only applies to Junior's who turned their Incentive Points in for the Previous Year.
All Points must be turned in by December 1st of said calendar year.**
